3. BRITISH CITIZENS WHO DO NOT HAVE THE STATUS OF CITIZEN OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND WITHIN THE MEANING OF THE LAW OF THE UNION:

British nationals (Overseas)

British overseas territories citizens (BOTC)

British overseas citizens (BOC)

British protected persons (BPP)

British subjects (BS)

4. ENTITIES AND TERRITORIAL AUTHORITIES NOT RECOGNIZED AS STATES BY AT LEAST ONE MEMBER STATE:

Taiwan (only for those in possession of a passport issued by Taiwan that includes an identity card number).
